FINALISTS WILL DEMONSTRATE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF LOW IMPACT DEVELOPMENT (LID) PRACTICES TO REDUCE RUNOFF, IMPROVE WATER QUALITY AND MANAGEMENT AND IMPROVE QUALITY OF LIFE. COMPETITORS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO **CONTRAST THE ECONOMICS OF THE LID-BASED DEVELOPMENT WITH THE SAME PROJECT IF DEVELOPED TRADITIONALLY.**

THE HOUSTON LAND/WATER SUSTAINABILITY FORUM WAS FORMED IN 2007, WITH THE EXPRESS PURPOSE OF RAISING THE LEVEL OF AWARENESS OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT METHODS AND PROVIDING THE NUTS-AND-BOLTS EDUCATION REQUIRED TO TRANSLATE THAT AWARENESS INTO ON THE GROUND USE OF THESE PRACTICES. WHILE OFTEN LEADING THE WAY WITH GROUNDBREAKING SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES INSIDE THE BUILDING ENVELOPE, PARTICULARLY IN THE AREA OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND LEED GREEN BUILDING STATUS, LOCAL DEVELOPMENT AND RE-DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS RARELY UTILIZED INNOVATIVE TECHNIQUES IN SITE DESIGN. THE FORUM'S STEERING COMMITTEE REPRESENTS THE SPECTRUM OF CONSTITUENCIES WHO HAVE A VESTED INTEREST IN THE CONTINUED ECONOMIC GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE HOUSTON AREA AND RECOGNIZE THAT THE ABILITY TO SUSTAIN THAT GROWTH IS DEPENDENT ON A SHIFT TO THE USE OF DEVELOPMENT METHODS THAT ARE SUSTAINABLE.
